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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND ANIMALS

CAUTION:

Humans - This collar is intended for use as an insecticide generator and is not to be taken internally by man or animal. Not intended for use on humans. The insecticide in this collar is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not allow children to handle or play with this collar.

Animals - Do not use other pesticides on animals wearing this collar. Some animals and humans may be sensitive to this collar. Remove at first sign of irritation or adverse reaction. Do not use on sick or convalescing animals.

Note to Physician: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result contact a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not open the protective pouch until ready to use. Place collar around animal's neck, adjust proper fit and buckle. Cut off excess and dispose of excess length. A properly fitted collar will allow two fingers to be inserted between collar and neck. If collar is worn too tightly, irritation might occur. Do not use more than one collar on dog.

Flea kill begins within 24 hours, reaching maximum effectiveness in 3-4 days and continuing for the 5 months. Ticks are somewhat harder to kill and die more slowly. Activity against ticks will occur within a few days and will continue killing and controlling ticks for up to 90 days. Fleas and ticks in the animal's environment which may reappear on the animal will be killed by the action of the collar. Replace collar as effectiveness diminishes.

The collar is unaffected by water and need not be removed even when the animal is bathed.

Do not allow the collar to come in contact with nursing bitches. Do not use on animals younger than six months.

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DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty pouch or box. Wrap pouch or box and put in trash collection. When discarding collar, wrap in newspaper and put in trash collection.

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
