DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions: Reppers Repellent Grains may be used as an aid to deter dogs and cats from defecating in or on gardens, lawns, shrubs and trees. This product must be applied in the plastic, mushroom-shaped evaporator (s) enclosed in this package. The evaporator is designed to prolong the effectiveness of the product giving protection from rain, light and excessive humidity.

Do not use this product indoors. Do not broadcast Reppers Repellent Grains or place this product unprotected in the area to be treated. Do not apply this product directly to pets.

- 1) Results can be improved by removing food elements and/or cleaning up prior defecation from the area to be treated.
- 2) High temperature and humidity may affect the length of time the product will be effective.
- 3) As with any product designed to modify behavior among animals, we highly recommend using an appropriate training regimen in conjunction with the use of Reppers repellent products to deter dogs and cats from gardens and ornaments.

Filling Evaporator: Unscrew the bowl-shaped lid from the base of the mushroom shaped evaporator. Hold or stand the base in a point-down position so that the top opening of the cylinder faces up. Use a funnel to load product into the chamber until it is completely filled. Screw the lid back onto the base.

Placing Evaporators: Push tapered lower portion of evaporator all the way into the ground near plants to be protected. When treating an area use more than one evaporator. Space evaporators no more than 12 feet apart. Place evaporators closer together in areas where dogs and cats habitually urinate or defecate.

Temperature and humidity may affect how long the product remains effective. Empty and refill applicators with fresh product if effectiveness decreases over time.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only at room temperatures, sealed in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly, securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
