

WHAT IS IT ?

Diatomaceous earth is made up of fossilized deposits of algae called diatoms. Diatoms weave tiny shells out of the silica they extract from water. As they die, their shells become fossilized into diatomaceous earth: ("D E") or diatomite.

HOW DOES IT WORK ?

The small sharp shells of diatomite scratch the wax coating on insect skeletons, causing the insect to lose moisture and die. D.E. does not kill instantly. Death by dehydration takes about 12 hours to incapacitate an insect.

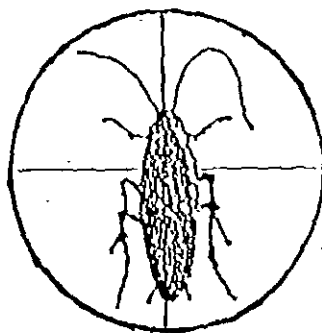
