It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTANT of hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood) including on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in substantial and one social offices, restrooms and work areas.

CLEANING AND DEODORIZING. Whenever practical, flush away grime soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing, use 2 1/2 to 4 ounces of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, wet vacuum system, or a mechanical spraying system. After cleaning remove suspended soils with a clear water vacuum, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, or cloth.

DISINFECTING. Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then, prepare 2 1/2 ounces of THIS DISINFECTANT per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired, the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OF GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES AND OTHER GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT.
