USE RESTRICTIONS:

This supplemental label applies to all M-44 Cyanide Capsules product (EPA Reg. No. 56228-15) with labeling dated prior to the revisions that were accepted by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on October 12, 2010. The elements of revised labeling accepted by EPA on October 12, 2010, include the label for individual M-44 Cyanide Capsules, the container label marked "Revised 10/2010", and the bulletin of "M-44 Use Restrictions" dated October 7, 2010.

Sales of products bearing labeling accepted prior to October 12, 2010, must be accompanied by this supplemental label and a copy of the bulletin of "M-44 Use Restrictions" dated October 7, 2010, which shall replace any earlier version sold with the product or previously obtained by the user. Users of this product must follow all requirements of product labeling, including but not limited to, all Use Restrictions, Directions for Use, Precautionary Statements, first aid and antidotal measures, information on endangered species, requirements for posting warning signs, and Storage and Disposal instructions.

This supplemental label expires on May 31, 2012.

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
