

FIRST AID: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TB-66 is used to control algae and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of TP-66 fluid ounces of TP-66 of water to provide a concentration of 40 to TB-66, based on the volume of water in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosages of TB-66 Subsequent slug additions of 1.20 to TB-66 per 1000 gallons of water. 100 parts per million of TB-66 should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the pump or sump. TB-66 is used to clean air-washing systems that maintain effective mist. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 21.37 to TB-66 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected. Dosages of 14.44 to 35.63 fluid ounces of TB-66 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the pump or sump. Slug additions may be made in the collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be disposed of promptly. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be disposed of by a registered or approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

PLASTIC: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reuse, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Do not burn. Do not incinerate.

METAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reuse, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Do not burn. Do not incinerate.
