 - d. It is preferred that all percentages of the carbon chain length in the Active Ingredient be distinctly separated from the 10% and 90% Ingredient section.



Repeat treatment every six months to condition vinyl and help to control bacteria growth.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Recap and wrap container and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
