

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

AU 15

is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and indoor swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness in swimming pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs, a heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using AU 15.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of AU 15 per 1,000 gallons of water. To remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a swimming pool add initially 27 to 50 fluid ounces of AU 15 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of AU 15 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 5 to 8 fluid ounces of AU 15 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly installed hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 3 fluid ounces of AU 15 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of AU 15 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. AU 15 is compatible with all other chlorine chemicals and is effective against algae.

AU 15 can be used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. However, do not mix AU 15 with other liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in plastic and dispose of with clear water.
