It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

AU 30 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of AU 30 fluid ounces of AU 30 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of AU 30 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh pool add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of AU 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of AU 30 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of AU 30 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of AU 30 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of AU 30 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. AU 30 is compared to other chlorine products and is effective. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
