The registrant is hereby notified in accordance with EPA Section 301(a)(4) that the following data are required:

1. Submit to the Agency all data required for registration or reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 301(b) when the Agency requires and registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- Add the phrase "EPA registration No. 56276-1."
- The statement "Keep out of Reach of Children" must appear on the label in the following order: "Caution," "Keep out of Reach of Children," and "EPA registration No. 56276-1" must appear on the front panel of the label and the statement "Keep out of Reach of Children."

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- d. The precautionary labeling section must be changed to read:

For external use only. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, lips or open cuts. Do not expose treated skin or clothing to fire, sparks or flame until liquid has evaporated. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated.

- e. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED - Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

IF ON SKIN - May cause skin reactions in rare cases. If so, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES - Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- f. Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the disposal statement.
- g. The word "Flammable" should precede the entire physical and chemical hazard statement.

3. The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) submitted with your application must be updated. A current copy of the CSF form is enclosed. This should be completed and submitted. Be sure to complete each section of the form. Provide the upper and lower certified limits for each component in the formulation as well as for each active ingredient in pure active form. Note that the lower limit of the active ingredients must not fall below the label claim for each active.

4. Submit the flashpoint of the product without the propellant. This information should appear on the CSF.

5. A storage stability study must be submitted for this product. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and for 1 year of storage. These data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this Registration Notice.

6. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

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If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
