

weeks after seedlings have been transplanted. For directly seeded tomatoes, make the application within 30 days after planting. The **BIOLURE**^R Technical Bulletin contains suggestions for trap placement. Monitor for insect infestation with traps and by visual inspection of leaves and fruit. Re-apply CHECKMATETM TPW every 75 days or sconer, based upon monitoring results and field scouting. CHECKMATETM TPW is best used to treat low populations of tomato pinworm and prevent their increase.
