

 - d. Change within ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS the phrase "Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of wastes." to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
 - e. Change within STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, the phrase "Wrap and dispose of used lures in regular trash collection." to "Securely wrap used lures in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

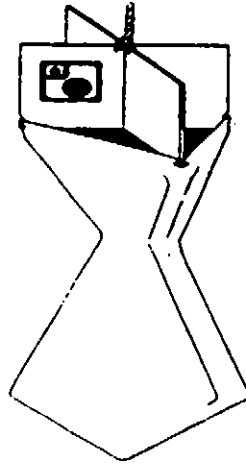

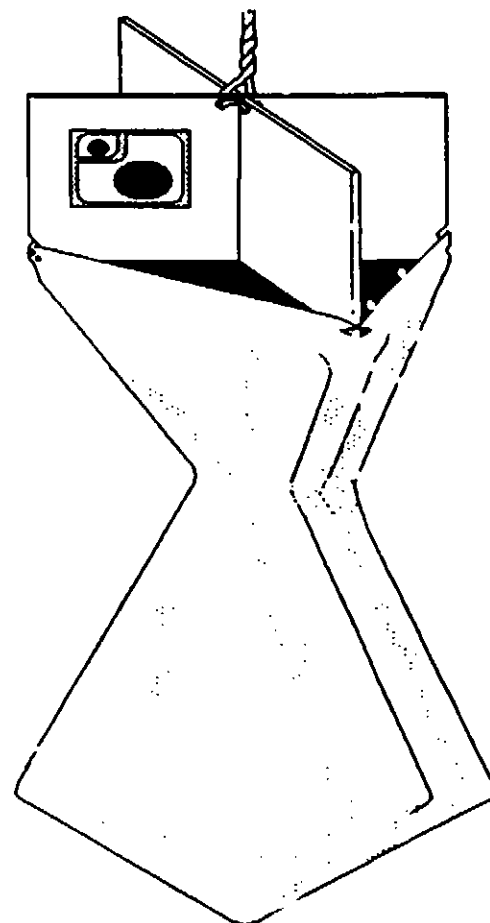

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Trap Assembly:

1. Slide vanes together at the slots to form a cross.
2. Attach the twist tie by inserting about 4" through the holes in the top of the vane assembly, as shown in the diagram, and twist to secure the trap.
3. Attach one of the disposable collection bags to the vane assembly by gently sliding the slits in the bag over the cutout hooks on the lower end of the trap vanes.
4. Remove the bait from its protective package. Peel the protective cover from the SUREFIRE™ JAPANESE BEETLE TRAP Lure.

5. Peel the backing from the back of the sex/floral lure (bait) and stick the bait onto the trap vane. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PEEL APART THE BAIT.** Best results are obtained by attaching the bait to the lower third of the trap vane. As trap catches decline, replace the bait.

Trap Placement and Use:

1. Place traps as beetles emerge or in mid-May to early June in Georgia and South Carolina; early June to mid-June in North Carolina and Tennessee; mid-June to early July in Kentucky, Delaware, Washington D.C., Virginia and West Virginia; early July to mid-July in Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania and New Jersey; mid-July in New York, Connecticut, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Vermont and Maine.
2. Place traps on the upwind side of the plantings to be protected. Use at least one trap per 50 feet along two sides of garden perimeter. Do not enclose the garden with traps.
3. Hang traps in sunny areas 3 to 5 feet above the ground from any suitable post or stand.
4. Place traps at least 10 feet away from plantings as they will attract beetles to the foliage if placed closer.
5. Replace bags when full.
