
3. Submit a corrected Confidential Statement of Formula which has item 7 completely filled out.

CheckMate® CM is a behavior modifying biochemical pheromone used for mating disruption, to be used in control of codling moth (*Cydia pomonella*) and hickory shuckworm (*Cydia caryana*).

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION: For use on apples, pome fruits; peaches, nectarines, plums, prunes, and other stone fruits. Rate of application of CheckMate® CM is 120 to 160 dispensers per hectare. For use on walnuts, pecans, and other nuts, the recommended application rate of CheckMate® CM is 150 to 200 dispensers per hectare (370 to 500 per hectare). Apply the first application early in the season, shortly before the first codling moth or hickory shuckworm pheromone trap, such as Biolure®. Monitor for insect infestation and by visual inspection of trees and fruit. Re-apply CheckMate® CM on monitoring results and field scouting.

METHOD OF APPLICATION: Use gloves when handling dispensers. Provide adequate ventilation when handling dispensers. Do not handle dispensers in a confined area. Hang dispensers from thumb-size tree limb to secure placement, 6 to 8 feet from the ground or higher, if desired, preferably on the north side. Wash hands after completion. Do not handle other types of pheromone traps or lure placement without thoroughly washing hands. Set codling moth traps before handling CheckMate® CM. Monitor treatments carefully for secondary pests such as leafrollers. Re-seal containers immediately after use, store unused product in a cool, dry place, or in freezers not used for food storage. Do not use CheckMate® CM in punctured or unsealed containers.
