The change provided via Notification is as follows:



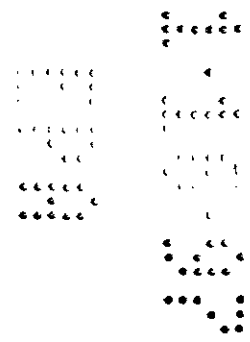

Do not exceed 22.156 [22] fluid ounces (655.021 [655] ml) product/acre/year (150 gm a.i./acre/year). Reapply as needed based on insect monitoring and field scouting programs.

MIXING and APPLICATION: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. DO NOT use CheckMate TPW-F from damaged, punctured, or unsealed containers. Use piston, diaphragm, or centrifugal pumps ONLY. DO NOT use roller or gear pumps as they will damage the TPW-F controlled release system. For best results, apply immediately after mixing.
