

METHOD OF APPLICATION: For disrupting the mating of the beet armyworm moth on sugar beet, parsley, parsnip, and other root and tuber vegetables; celery, head lettuce, leaf lettuce, spinach and other leafy vegetables; broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower and other cole crops; tomato, bell pepper, chili pepper, sweet pepper, tomatilo, and other fruiting vegetables; cotton; alfalfa; and those other crops where the beet armyworm is a pest.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

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DO NOT use CheckMate[®] BAW-F from damaged, punctured, or unsealed containers. Uso piston, diaphragm, or centrifugal pumps ONLY. DO NOT use roller or gear pumps as they wird damage the CheckMate BAW-F controlled release system. DO NOT use strainers or screen in spray equipment with openings smaller than 50 mesh. For best results, apply immediately after mixing. Do not let stand prior to application without thoroughly mixing again. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Terrestrial Applications: Apply CheckMate BAW-F at 2.04 fluid ounces (60.24 ml) of product per acre (10 g a.i./acre) to 4.07 fluid ounces (120.48 ml) product per acre (20 g a.i./acre). Do not exceed 30.55 fluid ounces (903.66 ml) product/acre/year (150 g a.i./acre/year).

Ground Equipment: Apply CheckMate BAW-F in sufficient water for uniform coverage. Do not apply to point of runoff. Apply to foliage directly.

Aerial Equipment: Apply CheckMate BAW-F in sufficient water for uniform coverage.

<u>Greenhouse Applications</u>: Apply CheckMate BAW-F as follows: Mix 5.5 ml of this product with 2.5 gallons of water and treat 1000 square feet of surface area. Do not treat to the point of runoff. Do not exceed a total of 20.9 ml of product per 1000 square feet per season.

GENERAL APPLICATION NOTES: Reapply as needed based on insect monitoring and field scouting programs. Use approved stickers for improved adherence to the leaf surface and protection from rainfall. In the event of rain, re-treatment is necessary if approved stickers are not used. Do not apply this product in fields with overhead irrigation. This product only affects adult male moths and will have no effect on female moths, eggs or larvae. If application occurs following biofix or during the growing season, the field must be treated with insecticide treatments that will effectively control hatching larvae until egg laying by previously mated female moths has ceased to occur. In moderate to high insect pressure situations, supplemental insecticide applications during the season can prove necessary to provide adequate protection to the developing crop. Make supplemental insecticide applications based on trap monitoring, field scouting, and appropriate degree-day models for the local growing area and timed to control emerging larvae.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
