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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. CheckMate® VMB-XL is a behavior modifying biochemical product (pheromone) which functions by mating disruption. It is to be used for control of the Vine Mealybug (*Planococcus ficus*) on raisin, table and wine grapes.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

The rate of application is 250 dispensers per acre. Do not exceed a total of 150 grams a.i./acre/year. Apply dispensers by hand to thumb-size canes or trellis wire to secure placement. Place dispensers in the upper one-third of the vines, or higher. If there is a persistent and prevalent wind, apply one dispenser to every vine on the upwind side of the vineyard and then evenly distribute the remaining dispensers in the block.

Wash hands after application. Do not handle other types of insect lures before or after dispenser placement without thoroughly washing hands. Place monitoring traps in the vineyard before handling CheckMate VMB-XL. Monitor treatments carefully.

Reseal containers immediately after use. Do not use from damaged, punctured or unsealed containers.

APPLICATION NOTES

For best results, apply at the time or shortly before the vine mealybug begins to emerge in the spring (blobs), or when males are first detected in pheromone traps. This product only affects adult males and will have no effect on females, eggs or immatures. The vineyard must be treated with insecticide that will effectively control hatching vine mealybug until egg laying by previously mated females has ceased to occur. In moderate to high insect pressure situations, supplemental insecticide applications during the season may be necessary to provide adequate protection to developing fruit. These supplemental insecticide applications should be made based on trap monitoring, field scouting and appropriate degree-day models for the local growing area and must be timed to control emerging vine mealybug. Monitor insect infestation with traps and by visual inspection of vines and fruit. Wash hands after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store container in cool place until used. Reseal containers immediately after use. Store unused product in a refrigerator or freezer not used for food storage.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on-site or at an approved disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Plastic containers: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

Bag/Cardboard Box: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Dispose of empty bag/cardboard box in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
