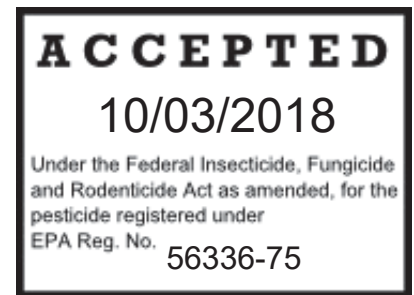

Not for direct treatment of pests. End-use mating disruption products formulated from this product must be registered by the US EPA.
