SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Apply to infected area until hair is thoroughly wet with product. Allow product to remain on area for 10 minutes but no longer. Wash area thoroughly with warm water and soap or shampoo. A fine toothed comb may be used to remove dead lice or their eggs (nits) from hair. A second treatment must be made in 7 to 10 days to kill any newly hatched lice. Use no more than 2 times in 24 hours.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Do not inhale. Keep out of eyes and avoid contact with mucous membranes. If product should get into eyes, immediately flush with plenty of water. If skin irritation or infection is present or develops, discontinue use and consult a doctor. Consult a doctor if infestation of eyebrows and eyelashes occurs. In order to prevent reinfestation with body lice all clothing must be sterilized concurrent with the application of this preparation.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS - HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**
