DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth to using ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment add initially 13 to 24 fluid ounces of ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 fluid ounces of ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE per 10,000 gallons of water every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 fluid ounces of ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 fluid ounces of ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE should be made for maintenance.

ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE will provide effective control of algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools treated during the swimming season and are free of algae. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add 21 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. It may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times.

ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE is compatible with chlorine used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE can be used with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix ALGAE OUT CONCENTRATE with chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or broken containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wash thoroughly before reuse.
