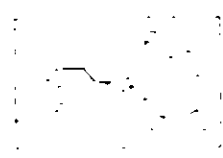

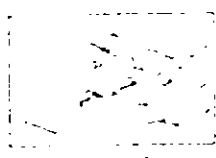

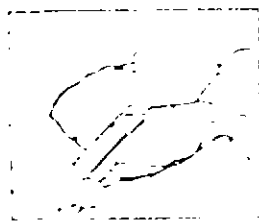

For use on bulls, insert the tag into the ear when the bull is handled. For use on steers, insert the tag into the ear when the steer is handled. Apply with the A-Tek[®] Tagging System.
