1. Delete "Veterinary Product" from the labeling. Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics are not acceptable.
2. Add the following precautionary statement:

Do not use on nursing kittens or o cats under 3 months of age.

~~Submit the product-specific product chemistry data for your product since we do not have this information on file for the subject product.~~

You may replace Di-2-ethyl hexyl phthalate with Di(2-ethylhexyl)adipate.

~~You are reminded that labeling must be in compliance with the Guidance for the Reregistration of Pesticide Products Containing DDVP By October 1, 1988.~~
