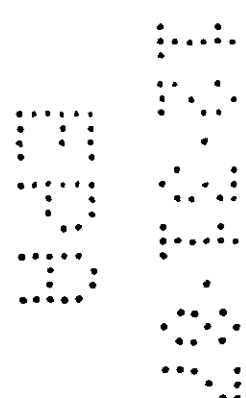

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Statement of Practical Treatment

If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.

If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and water.

If in eyes—Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to physicians—If signs of cholinesterase inhibition are observed, atropine is antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with 2-PAM (Praldoxime Chloride). Product may cause aspiration pneumonia. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger

Corrosive. Causes eye damage, causes skin irritation. Do not get in eyes (including animals), on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist.

Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of food.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Physical and Chemical Hazards

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty bottle. Wrap bottle and put in trash collection.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Kenner Yard Spray Concentrate is effective as a residual surface spray and larvicide for the control of Flies, Fly Maggots, Mosquitoes, Ticks, Spiders and Gnats in and around Horse Barns and other Animal Buildings. Also controls Fleas and Ticks in yards, dog houses and run areas.

Kenner Yard Spray Concentrate is suitable for use in conventional power or low pressure knapsack sprayers. Follow the USE DIRECTIONS for the proper method of controlling specific insects.

Must be diluted. Refer to the DILUTION TABLE for the quantity of this product to mix with water to obtain the percent solution recommended.

Use Directions

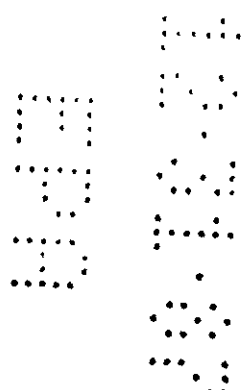
Insects Controlled	Remarks
House Flies	Remove cobwebs and dust from wall surfaces. Apply a 1% solution to the walls, ceilings and other fly resting areas with a coarse spray to the point of runoff. Spray 1 gallon of mixed solution for every 500-1000 sq. ft.
Stable Flies	
Gnats	
Mosquitoes	
Spiders	
Wasps	Drench wasp nests thoroughly with a 1% solution in the evening when the wasps are quiet or when they are away from their nests.
Fly Maggots	Apply 1 gallon of a 1% solution by sprayer or sprinkler can to every 100 sq. ft. of manure, old wet straw in box stalls, under or around feed troughs, or similar fly breeding areas.
Ticks	Thoroughly treat infested yard & kennel areas with 0.5% spray.
Fleas	Avoid direct contact with flowers and shrubs.

Note: Extreme infestations of flies, biting gnats, mosquitoes, spiders and wasps in barns may necessitate increasing the dosage to a 2% solution.

Do not apply to pets. Allow treated areas to dry before allowing animals access to areas.
