BACK PANEL

Ectogard Aerosol House & Carpet Spray contains a unique combination of three insecticides that attack the flea life cycle from three directions, plus controls ticks, cockroaches, crickets, silverfish, earwigs, sowbugs, confused flour beetles, ants, spiders & flies. 1) The first action is provided by the extremely effective quick-killing activity of S-bioallethrin which rapidly kills insects upon direct contact. 2) Permethrin is the second active ingredient. It takes over as the S-bioallethrin loses effectiveness by providing a residual control of fleas in carpet. 3) The third & most important ingredient is the new photostable insect growth regulator, Tenocide. It inhibits development of the immature stages of the flea for 32 weeks, preventing them from reaching the biting adult stage. Tenocide controls fleas for 32 weeks in sunny as well as shaded areas.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Remove contaminated clothing & wash before reuse. Do not contaminate food or foodstuffs. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For the most effective results, all carpeted surfaces should be thoroughly vacuumed, the entire dwelling should be treated. Use one can to treat 750 sq. ft. For use in homes, garages, attics, apartments, hotels, kennels, dog houses & outdoor areas around the house where pets lie or sleep.

BACK PANEL (Cont)

PREPARATION: Cover exposed foods, dishes & food handling equipment. Open cabinets & closet doors to areas to be treated. Turn off fans & air conditioners. Extinguish all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets. Cover aquariums or fish bowls, or remove from area. Pet bedding is a primary hiding place for fleas & must be thoroughly treated or replaced for best results. Close outside doors & windows.

APPLICATION: Before spraying remove pets. To apply product, hold can upside down at arm's length directing spray towards area to be treated. Move arm in a reverse sweeping motion by backing away from treated area. Immediately exit area. Do not be or allow pets to be in contact with a treated surface when wet; allow enough time for treated surface to completely dry. Before re-occupying, open all outside doors & windows; turn on air conditioner & fans; & let treated area air for 30 minutes. Thoroughly clean all covered food processing areas before using.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store in a cool area away from children. Replace cap, wrap in newspaper & discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
