- b. Split the Precautionary Statements into two sections: HAZARDS TO HUMANS and HAZARDS TO ANIMALS. The HAZARDS TO HUMANS statement on the label is acceptable. Add the following HAZARDS TO ANIMALS:

HAZARDS TO ANIMALS: Some animals may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. Following treatment observe your pet for possible signs of sensitivity or adverse reactions to product, such as salivation and depression.

- c. Add the statement, "To prevent harm to you and your pet, read entire label before use."

- d. Add the statement, "Do not use on puppies or kittens under 6 weeks old."
- e. Add the statement, Consult your veterinarian before using this product on pregnant or lactating females, old, sick, or debilitated animals, or on animals undergoing drug or other pesticide treatment."
- f. Add the statement, "If animal has adverse effects after the use of this product, discontinue use and immediately seek veterinary advice." under the Statement Of Practical Treatment.
- g. Delete the statement, "This product is not a cholinesterase inhibitor."

3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

For Dogs, Cats, Puppies and Kittens: Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke, to get proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray the neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing with legs last. Apply spray until animal is uniformly damp. Animal should not be soaked or sprayed to the point of run-off. For best penetration, spray against natural lay of the hair. On a heavily coated animal, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind your hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets attached ticks. Repeat as necessary for control of adult fleas but not more frequently than once every 7 days. Allow spray to dry before allowing cats to groom themselves. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after treating pet.

Use this product in a well ventilated area. This product is not a cholinesterase inhibitor. This product is not intended for application to nursing animals.

For Resting Quarters & Kennels: Apply evenly as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as dog houses, pet beds, resting quarters, kennels & outdoor areas around the house where the pet lays or sleeps. Old bedding should be sprayed thoroughly or replaced for best results. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Remove birds & cover aquariums/fish bowls. Repeat as necessary.

For Pet's Environment: For maximum flea control, the infested areas should be treated according to label use directions with Ptenocide™ Aerosol House & Carpet Spray, available from your veterinarian.
