"Contain petroleum distillate, Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard, incase of contact wash with plenty of soap & water, wash thoroughly, etc..."

LAWN FLEA CONTROL: To kill fleas barboring in lawns use this concentrate with the enclosed hous-end sprayer (see side panel). For best results fawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pots will somally frequent. Spray using or flowering plants. The contents of this package covers 3,000 square feet. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals. Kills on contact the lander dominin tick (Deer tick), which transmits Lyme disease. Also kills foraging fire ants upon direct contact. A registered fire ant mound treatment should also be used in conjunction with this product.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the apray has dried. Do not apray product directly on animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flee and tick control product in conjunction with this application.
