- d. Delete the following statements from the precautionary statement since these statements already appears on the label in its appropriate location:

"Contain petroleum distillate, Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard, incase of contact wash with plenty of soap & water, wash thoroughly, etc..."

- e. The statement should read "Do Not Treat Pets/Animals With This Products." Delete the statement do not spray product directly on animals.

3. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LAWN FLEA CONTROL: To kill fleas harboring in lawns use this concentrate with the enclosed hose-end sprayer (see side panel). For best results lawns should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamentals and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. The contents of this package covers 3,000 square feet. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals. Kills on contact the *Ixodes dammini* tick (Deer tick), which transmits Lyme disease. Also kills foraging fire ants upon direct contact. A registered fire ant mound treatment should also be used in conjunction with this product.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray product directly on animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this application.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS: Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of two (2) fluid ounces per one (1) gallon of water to control on contact cockroaches, palmetto bugs, ants, crickets, sowbugs, spiders and ticks. Use at the rate of one (1) gallon (diluted spray) per 1000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

BUILDING PERIMETER TREATMENT: To prevent infestations of building by ants, crickets, spiders, centipedes and sowbugs, treat a 12-18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance. Use eight (8) fluid ounces of concentrate per one-half (1/2) gallon of water and apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of one (1) gallon per 500 square feet.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air or if not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled, causes moderate eye irritation. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist and contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. HOSE-END SPRAYER: The end sprayer is calibrated to the dilution rate for lawn flea measuring necessary. Spray back of sprayer. Insert end sprayer. Remove bottle cap (save for storage after use) by turning bottle counter-water supply. TO START INSECTICIDE, place in RIGHT side of sprayer completely over lawns and giving special attention to pets. Hold about 3 feet at a steady pace to insure coverage. When treatment wish TO STOP FLOW for any reason, simply remove break siphon action. TO REMAINING INSECTICIDE supply and remove bottle hose by turning bottle clockwise and tighten securely. Unscrew hose from sprayer clear water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Remove spray nozzle and cap.

Do not contaminate water, storage or disposal.
Store in original container open flame, in cool, locked reuse container. Do not reuse nozzle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
