SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED

This product will kill ants, cockroaches, crickets, fleas, weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, small flying moths, and preadult fleas from developing into the adult biting stage. Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment in area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from area when releasing. Use one unit for each 750 square feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms. Success is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Leave before re-entry.

To Operate Valve: To lock valve in open position for treatment, push the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Place a table in the center of the room with valve locked open. Lay newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows for 15 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when needed.
To Control Fleas & Ticks: Old bedding should be replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment. Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or in an area less than 12.5 square feet (100 cubic feet).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash.
