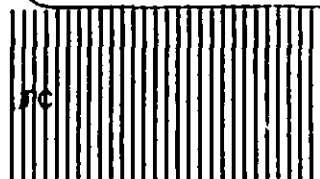
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL Avoid excessive heat. Do not reuse empty bottle. Wrap bottle and put in trash.

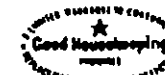

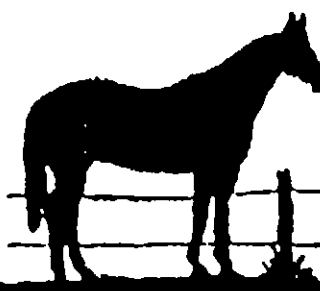
