Dear Ms. Laird:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

General Statement:

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

<u>Directions for Use section comment(s):</u>

2. Replace the last sentence from this section with: "NOTE: Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, Spandex or other synthetic fabrics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics (such as eyeglasses and watch crystals), leather and painted or varnished surfaces (including automobiles)."

Storage and Disposal section comment(s):

3. Relocate the Storage and Disposal section to appear on the label immediately following the First Aid section and replace the "Pesticide Disposal:" subsection with: "Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available."

<u>Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section comment(s):</u>

- 4. Insert the signal word "WARNING" immediately following the section title.
- 5. Relocate this section to appear on the label immediately preceding the Directions for Use section.

First Aid Statement (table) comment(s):

 Replace the 2nd sentence starting with "For more information ..." with: "For more information on this pesticide product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-800-xxx-xxxx." ¹

¹ Please note that the "1-800-xxx-xxxx" must be substituted with a valid phone number that is available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.

Tender Corporation should note that the Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions. A copy of your label for this product stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Tear open sachet near notched end. Remove and unfold wipe (towelette). Repellents should be applied only to exposed skin as directed on this product label. Do not use under clothing. Use just enough of this product to cover exposed skin. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply product to your child yourself. Instruct older children in the proper use of this product. Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) and under. Reapply as necessary or after swimming or showering. Apply this product second if used in conjunction with a sunscreen product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Also, wash treated clothing before wearing it again. NOTE: Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, Spandex or other synthetic fabrics, nylon furniture, plastics (such as eyeglasses and watch crystals), leather and painted or varnished surfaces (including automobiles).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Store this product in a cool and dry (preferably locked) area inaccessible to children or pets and away from heat or open flame. **Pesticide Disposal:** If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
