


<p>On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.</p> <p>Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. 
- c) According to your Confidential Statement of Formula your product is not pressurized. Revise the Physical Hazards Statement to read: "Flammable. Do not use or store near sparks or open flame. Do not smoke while applying." Note that you cannot market this product as an aerosol or in a pressurized container unless you amend the label, CSF, cite or submit additional product chemistry data, and provide more information on product packaging. The product as submitted and approved for registration is a 'me-too' of a pump-spray formulation.
- d) You have only listed mosquitoes and ticks on the label. Therefore, the reference to 'insects' has been deleted and replaced with mosquitoes. The "Do not inhale." statement was removed because it was not required. Revise the directions for use to read:

"Hold 4 to 6 inches from skin while spraying keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Slightly moisten the skin with a slow sweeping motion. Excessive amounts or frequent reapplication is unnecessary. Do not spray directly on face or in enclosed areas. To apply to face, spray small amounts on palms of hands and rub on face and neck. Do not apply to the hands of small children. Reapply every eight hours. Do not exceed two applications per day. Avoid contact with lips, cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin. Do not apply under clothing. Apply sparingly around ears. Repels mosquitoes and ticks for up to eight hours."

3. Add a street address to the label for the registrant.
4. Revise the basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated August 21, 2008 to reflect the change to the % active ingredient of the source product, which was recently amended by that registrant to increase the nominal picaridin content to 98.7%. This requires you to revise entries in Boxes 10 and 13. You will have to increase the %weight of one of the inert ingredients to compensate for the decreased %weight of the source product. Submit a revised CSF immediately.
5. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
