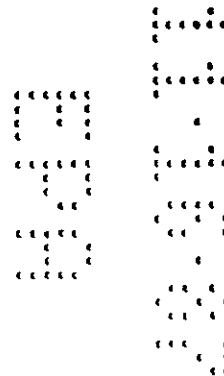

PITTSBURGH PAINTS new MILDEW CHECK Wash (Patent Pending) is a mildewcidal/algicidal/disinfectant wash specially formulated for cleaning and killing mildew, algae, and bacteria that cause paint discoloration.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WHERE AND HOW TO USE: MILDEW CHECK Wash may be use on painted, stained, or bare wood siding, wood fences and decks, aluminum siding, other painted metals, stucco, roofing, brick or cement block, concrete walkways and walls, ceramic tile and grout. It cleans and disinfects the surface prior to painting or may be used for routine clean-up. MILDEW CHECK Wash may be used on structural or other surfaces in official establishments operating under the Federal Meat and Poultry Products Inspection Program. Do not use on direct food contact surfaces.

CLEANS WITHOUT SCRUBBING - In most cases, mold, mildew, algae, bacteria causing discoloration and loose dirt are rinsed away after application. MILDEW CHECK Wash does not remove imbedded dirt.

EASY TO USE - No measuring required. Simply add household bleach to the fill line on the MILDEW CHECK Wash container. Shake well and apply as directed. (See Application Directions).

RESISTS REGROWTH OF MILDEW AND ALGAE - MILDEW CHECK Wash differs from ordinary washes by leaving a protective shield (Patent Pending) that inhibits regrowth. This protection remains after rinsing and is water insoluble. Its effectiveness lasts even after new paint is applied, by inhibiting growth of mold, mildew or algae from behind the freshly applied paint.

AREA PREPARATION AND PRE-TEST - Spray all shrubs and foliage liberally with water and cover with plastic or cloth. After applying and thoroughly rinsing MILDEW CHECK Wash from affected areas, uncover all shrubs and foliage and rinse well with water. Prevent solution from coming in contact with material which might be damaged by dilute bleach, such as fabric and lawn furniture.

When using MILDEW CHECK Wash without repainting, pretest a small hidden area for color fastness and resistance to surface paint lifting. Combine one tablespoon of household bleach with 1/3 cup of MILDEW CHECK Wash and mix well. Sponge, dab, or brush the solution onto test area and allow to set for 20 minutes. Rinse well. If color fading or lifting is noted, wait 24 hours and re-check. If fading or lifting is still a problem, the surface will require repainting after cleaning.

COVERAGE: - When applied evenly to a painted surface, one diluted gallon (3.78 L) will clean 200-250 sq. ft. (18.5-23.2 sq. meters).

SURFACE PREPARATION - No special preparation is required when used as a mildewcidal/algicidal/disinfectant wash. See application precautions and apply and use as directed. When repainting after washing, apply MILDEW CHECK Wash as directed, rinse thoroughly; wait 24-48 hours before painting. Prepare the surfaces as required before repainting.

TOPCOATING WITH PAINT - MILDEW CHECK Wash is formulated for optimum performance when topcoating with any of the following PITTSBURGH PAINTS products:

- * SUN-PROOF Exterior Oil Base House and Trim Paint (1 Line)
- * Metal Siding Refinish Latex Enamel (71 Line)
- * SUN-PROOF Exterior Latex Flat House Paint (72 Line)
- * SUN-PROOF Exterior Latex Semi-Gloss Enamel (78 Line)
- * PITT-FLEX 100% Acrylic Latex Elastomeric Masonry Paint (4-110)

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS - Add household bleach (only sodium hypochlorite type at 5.25% concentration) to the fill line of the MILDEW CHECK Wash container. For volumes other than one gallon, use 5.5 parts MILDEW CHECK Wash to 1 part household bleach. (IMPORTANT! Always follow manufacturer's precautions and handling instructions on bleach products. It is important to use fresh household bleach because after standing six months or longer, bleach deteriorates and may no longer be sufficiently potent.) Shake well. Once household bleach is added to MILDEW CHECK Wash, as directed, the product is ready to use. DO NOT DILUTE WITH WATER. This will adversely affect the product's effectiveness.

Use immediately after mixing, since mixture life is two hours. After this time, MILDEW CHECK Wash begins to lose its effectiveness and should be discarded, because a pungent odor begins to form.

APPLICATION EQUIPMENT - Recommended garden sprayers: LARGE AREA APPLICATIONS: Solo brand with pressure release valve, optional air valve for air compressor, and fan nozzle or Hudson brand garden sprayer or Spray Doc Sprayer Model 201P.. SMALL AREA APPLICATIONS: Preval Auto Sprayer.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS - MILDEW CHECK Wash should be applied with a tank type garden sprayer, preferably with a nozzle that provides a fan spray. Spray the infested area liberally. Bleaching action may not be immediate, but will occur within minutes. Let stand for 15-20 minutes for best results. Rinse well with a garden hose, with nozzle pressure at maximum force. Use lots of water to completely rinse the surface. For very heavy mildew stains, you may need to repeat the process. Textured surfaces, such as stucco or rough sawn cedar may require light scrubbing.

APPLICATION PRECAUTIONS - When applying and rinsing MILDEW CHECK Wash, overspray or rinse water in contact with walking surfaces, ladders and scaffolding may cause them to become slippery. Thoroughly clean all such surfaces to remove overspray and rinse water before using. Avoid contact with fabrics sensitive to discoloration from bleach. Do not use when the temperature of the air, the surface or MILDEW CHECK Wash is below 50 F (10 C). Do not allow MILDEW CHECK Wash to freeze.
