Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the above named product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. Replace the text of the Environmental Hazards section with the following:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

Since one of your suppliers' products has been reregistered with a label claim of 12.5% sodium hypochlorite (and the other supplier's product will presumably be reregistered at 12.5% also) you must change your label claim for sodium hypochlorite from 13% to 12.5%. Also change the percentage of inert ingredients to 87.5%.

Note that one of your suppliers' products, formerly EPA Reg. No. 35317-1 has a new Registration Number 35317-20001.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.
