The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes and submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling before you ship product:

- From the standpoint of efficacy, the proposed outer package and placepack labels submitted on June 27, 1995, are acceptable, subject to the comments below.
  - a. On both labels, center the headings "DIRECTIONS FOR USE", "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL", "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS", "HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS", "CAUTION", and "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS".
  - b. In first sentence of "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:" for "Rats:" on both labels, change "place packs" to "placepacks".
  - c. The promotional claim proposed in your letter of June 27, 1995, is acceptable in principle as it appears to us to be true. Some punctuation is needed so that it is clear that you are not talking about "Poison A". The claim also may not be unduly emphasized relative to required label text. The claim would be acceptable if expressed as follows:

"Sweet Corn and Poison -- A Fatal Attraction".

2. The placepack label submitted with your letter of August 25, 1995, is not acceptable because the proposed shortened qualifying statement makes a positive claim about something which actually is a "negative", namely the small amount of bait contained in a single placepack.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
