This is in reference to your draft labeling submitted January 8, 1988 in response to the Methiocarb Registration Standard.

The labeling referred to above is acceptable provided that you submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.

1. Correct the name of the active ingredient in the ingredient statement to read as follows:

Methiocarb (4-methylthio-3,5-xylylmethylcarbamate)

2. Please note that, in accordance with the methiocarb Standard, all commercial and agricultural uses of methiocarb are classified as restricted use pesticides. Additionally, the Standard imposed an interim 24 hour reentry interval for several uses including commercial turf. Your submitted labeling includes the unqualified claim for use on turf.

Therefore, to preclude possible use on commercial turf areas which would require the labeling restrictions described above, the use on turf must be qualified to denote use on home lawns only.

SECURITY SNAIL & SLUG BAIT is an easy-to-use pellet formulation that effectively controls slugs and snails in ornamental gardens and turf areas. Simply scatter the pellets directly from the container. For best results, water area to be treated prior to application. This product can be applied any time during the day, but late afternoon is preferred.

FOR ORNAMENTAL GARDENS, PLANTED BORDERS, AND GROUND COVERS: To control snails and slugs - Water area to be treated before application. Apply 1 pound to 1000 square feet. Scatter pellets uniformly over the infested area and around the edges of border or ground cover plants. Do not apply directly to plant foliage. Apply also to the bases of fences and walls and in shady protected areas. Repeat as necessary to keep areas free of slugs and snails. Do not put pellets in piles. Withhold heavy watering for at least 2 days after treatment. However, it foliage and soil surface become dry after application, a light sprinkling applied at dusk will encourage movement and increase feeding on the bait. Do not use around food crops.

FOR TURF AREAS: To control snails and slugs - Water area to be treated before application. Apply 1 pound uniformly to 1000 square feet by scattering directly from the container or by using a granular applicator. Do not put pellets in piles. Withhold heavy watering for at least 2 days after treatment. After application, sprinkle turf lightly to wash pellets from foliage to soil. Keep children and pets off the treated area until it has dried.

IMPORTANT: Do not use on or around plants grown for food. Do not put pellets in piles. Scatter so that pellets are hardly visible on the treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage - Store in a dry area inaccessible to children.

Disposal - Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.
