Animal Repellent is used to deter browsing damage to ornamental trees and shrubs, ground cover, and flowers by white-tailed deer, black-tailed deer, and rabbits. See USE RESTRICTIONS and APPLICATION DIRECTIONS below.

Animal Repellent also is used to deter damage to ornamental trees and shrubs, ground cover, and flowers by pocket gophers, and damage around the home caused by raccoons and gray squirrels. See USE RESTRICTIONS and APPLICATION DIRECTIONS on opposite side panel.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE (DEER AND RABBITS)**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**USE RESTRICTIONS**

For repelling white-tailed deer (Odocoileus virginianus), black-tailed deer (O. hemionus), and rabbits (Sylvilagus spp.) from ornamental trees and shrubs, ground cover, and flower gardens. For outdoor use only. Keep product about one foot away from plants and painted surfaces. Do not use product within vegetable gardens. Do not apply to or near dichondra or unusual ground cover. Do not apply on or near fruit or nut-bearing trees. Do not apply in or around poultry houses.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**

**DEER:** Treat ground cover by spreading evenly, not in piles, at the rate of 1 lb. per 55 sq. ft. Scatter around ornamental trees where browsing of lower branches or damage to bark is noticed. Cardboard cartons containing Animal Repellent, with holes punched in upper sides, may be hung from branches of trees or fastened to tree trunks and fences.

**RABBITS:** Apply at the rate of 1 lb. per 55 sq. ft. around plants where browsing damage occurs or where rabbit droppings are noticed. Spread evenly around vegetable gardens (not within the gardens) and around and in between flowers and other ornamentals. Re-treat once a week until no more damage occurs.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE (POCKET GOPHERS,  
RACCOONS, AND GRAY SQUIRRELS)**

**USE RESTRICTIONS**

For repelling pocket gophers (Geomys spp. and Thomomys spp.) from ornamental ground cover and flower gardens, and for repelling raccoons (Procyon lotor) and gray squirrels (Sciurus carolinensis) from areas around homes. For outdoor use only. Keep product about one foot away from plants and painted surfaces. Do not use product within vegetable gardens. Do not apply to or near dichondra or unusual ground cover. Do not apply on or near fruit or nut-bearing trees. Do not apply in or around poultry houses.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**

**POCKET GOPHERS** (Geomys spp. and Thomomys spp.): Apply at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 sq. ft. around plants where damage occurs. Place in the burrow if at all possible, 1/2 lb. per burrow. It will be more effective if the mouth of the burrow is closed either with a stone or with dirt. If gopher reopens the burrow or appears elsewhere, repeat the above procedure.

**RACCOONS:** Treat areas around vegetable gardens (not within), garbage cans and other places where raccoon damage occurs. Apply at the rate of 1 lb. per 55 sq. ft. and repeat once a week until no further damage occurs. Raccoons will often nest in nooks and crannies around garages and storage sheds. When nest is found, place a cardboard container containing Animal Repellent, with holes punched in upper sides, as close to the nest as possible. Since raccoons are nocturnal in habit, apply in early evening.

**GRAY SQUIRRELS:** Apply at the rate of 1 lb. per 55 sq. ft. around the base of trees, poles, fence posts and any area where squirrels are a nuisance. Spread evenly, not in piles. Repeat at least once per week until squirrels are no longer a nuisance. Repeat treatment if problem reoccurs.
