It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read complete label thoroughly. Do not use if all instructions are fully understood. Chacon Weed-O-Kil is formulated to kill both shallow and deep rooted grasses and broad leaf weeds, as well as woody plants. Some of the more common are:

For use in non-crop areas: Driveways, patios, walks, around buildings, along fences and gutters.

Chacon Weed-O-Kil may be used in two different ways:

#### FIRST, TO CONTROL UNWANTED VEGETATION IN NON-CROP AREAS:

To kill existing vegetation: Be sure there is moisture in the soil before application is made. Use at the rate of 1 qt. in 5 gals. of water applied to 300 sq. ft. Do not apply to soil, apply to foliage of vegetation to be killed. Water lightly 48 hours after application.

#### SECOND, TO PREVENT SOIL UP TO 1 YEAR:

For killing vegetation up to 1 year, use 1 qt. in 5 gals. of water applied to 185 sq. ft. Apply to both soil and vegetation. Be sure there is moisture in the soil before application is made. Water heavily 48 hours after application. Second application must be made for control of deep rooted perennials such as Bermuda Grass, St. Augustine, Wild Morning Glory, Dallis Grass, also Yellow Nutgrass.

Do not mow weeds before application. If weeds are more than 6 inches high, additional application may be necessary. Repeat at two week intervals if needed.

Woody plants such as trailing ivies and poison oak, should be sprayed when in full foliage.

Big shrubs and trees have extensive root systems that often extend over large areas. Be sure there are no such roots in areas treated. Severe damage or kill could result. Do not apply when wind could blow the spray onto valuable plants.
