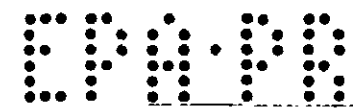

Apply as a thorough foliar spray. Wet the plants to the dripping point. Try to hit the under-sides of leaves and penetrate dense foliage.

FRUITS AND NUTS: Apples, Apricots, Nectarines, Cherries, Strawberries, Grapes, Grapefruits, Lemons, Oranges, Peaches, Walnuts. Controls Aphids, Apricot Mealybugs, Spider Mites, Mites (Clove or Brown, Two Spotted, European Red, Pacific, or Two Spotted Spider), Scale (Cottony-Cushion, San Jose), Coddling Moths, Fruit Leaf Rollers, Cherry Fruit Flies, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs (Apple), and Mealybugs. Use 1 lb. oz. in 3 gallons of water. Apply as a full cover spray. Start spraying after blooming, and again in the summer. Applications should be made according to infestation or when Aphids, Mites, and other stages of Scale insects are first noticed. If warranted, repeat application at 7 to 10 day intervals. On apples, slight russeting may occur on some varieties such as Golden Delicious. Do not spray within the following number of days before harvest: Strawberries—5 days; Apricots, Cherries, Nectarines, Grapes—10 days; Apples—14 days; Grapefruit, Lemons, Oranges, Peaches, Walnuts—21 days. Do not apply after harvest open or split.

VEGETABLES: Beans, Peas, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Broccoli, Radishes, Squash, Carrots, Lettuce, Cantaloupes, Cucumbers, Sweet Corn, Onions, Peppers, Potatoes, Tomatoes. Controls Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mexican Bean Beetles, Mites, Downy-mildew Mites, Flea Beetles, Imported Cabbage Worms, Destructive Leaf Miners, Thrips, Colorado Potato Beetles, Fall Armyworms (Tomato), Onion Thrips, Southern Armyworms (Potato and Tomato). Use 1 lb. oz. in 3 gallons of water, covers 1000 sq. ft. of garden. Do not spray within the following number of days before harvest: 1 day—Peas, Tomatoes, Sweet Corn, 3 days—Cantaloupes; 5 days—Broccoli, Cauliflower; 7 days—Beans, Cabbage, Cucumbers, Peppers, Squash; 10 days—Carrots, Lettuce, Onions, Radishes; 35 days—Potatoes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool place away from sparks or open flame. Keep out of reach of children.
Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of paper and discard in trash. Do not reuse container.

WARNING
Keep out of reach of children. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not inhale the spray mist. May be absorbed through the mouth. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and be sure eating or drinking. Avoid contact with children and pets. Do not use on household pets or humans. Keep out of reach of children and animals.
Statement of Practical Treatment: If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. If inhaled, remove affected person from exposure. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash affected skin areas with soap and water. Note: In Physician: Solvent presents some hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken orally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is indicated. 2-PAM is also indicated and may be used in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding in the treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Shrimp and Crab may be killed at application rate recommended on this label. Do not apply where these are important resources. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining in the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting the crop. Cover crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Application should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

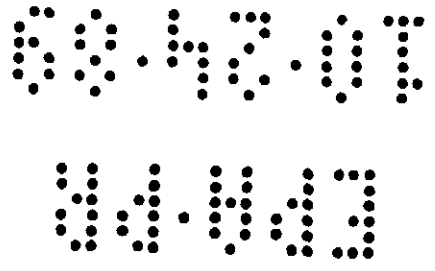
PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL STANDARDS

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal Law to use this product for a purpose inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label thoroughly. Apply this product only as specified on this label. DO NOT USE INSIDE THE HOME.
Determine size of spraying job. For lawns and vegetables measure the area to be sprayed for all other applications, apply as thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear. Be sure to spray under side of leaves. Repeat applications as needed or as stated in the directions. Use contents within 6 months after opening. (Note: Do not use on Ferns, Pansies, Hibiscus, Papaya, Pilea, Gardenias and Orchids, since injury might occur.)
LAWNS: Berm. Bermuda, Dichondra, Fescue, Marion, St. Augustine. Controls Ants, Armyworms, Bermuda Grass Thrips, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Fleas, Fruit Flies, Lawn Billbugs, Lawn Mites (Sod Webworms), Leafhoppers, Mites (Bermuda, Clover), Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Springtails (Collembola), Wintergrass, Scales. Use 1 lb. oz. in 3 gallons of water per 125 sq. ft. Thoroughly wet down grass a few hours before applying. Keep children and pets out of area until area has completely dried. For Lawn Billbugs, water lawn immediately after treatment.
TIRES AND SHRUBS: Arborvitae, Aralia, Birch, Burmese, Camellia, Elm, Juniper, Maple, Oak, Pine, Poplar, Weeping Dandelion, Spruce, Willow. Controls Aphids, Bagworms, Leaf Miners, Mites (Clover, Cyclamen, European Red, Privet, Two Spotted Spider), Scale Crawlers (Cottony Cushion Eucymus, Pine Needle Ph Scale, San Jose, Soft). Use 1 lb. oz. in 3 gallons of water. Apply as thorough foliar spray. Wet both sides of leaves and branches to the dripping point. Try to penetrate dense foliage.
ROSES AND FLOWERS: Azaleas, Camellias, Chrysanthemums, Carnations, Gladiolus, Lilies, Rhododendrons, Roses. Controls Aphids, Eucymus Scale Crawlers, Flea Beetle, Destructive Leaf Miners, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Thrips, White Flies. Use 1 lb. oz. in 3 gallons of water.
