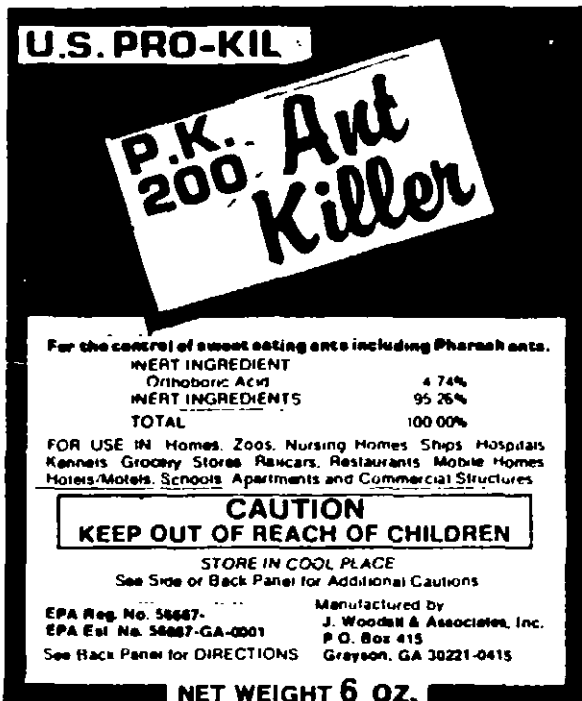

1. Outdoors: Press pointed tube into soil until flush with surface. Cover lightly with pine needles, dry grass, dry leaves etc. etc.
2. Indoors: Tape tube to back of refrigerator, stove, inside cabinets and drawers or wherever ants are seen that is OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN
