- d. In the third sentence after "for sanitizing garbage cans . . ." the claim for 16 ounces of this product per gallon of water should read 1 part to 7 parts water, not 1 part to 10 parts water.



e. In "Industrial areas, barber shops," the 10 ounces per 1 1/2 gallon water does not equal 1 part to 7 parts of water. It really equals 1 part to 18 parts water.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
