Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillate. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol. **If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If On Skin Or Clothing:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use to kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Hornets, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Silverfish, Small Flying Moths, Ticks and Wasps.

Put out all flames and pilot lights. Cover all exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry. **Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use this unit in an areas less than 100 cubic feet.**

To operate valve: Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. For automatic discharge, lock valve in open position by pressing valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table (in center of room) with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. To air out, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying room. Repeat treatment in two weeks or as necessary.

To Control Ticks and Fleas: Discard pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Do not use this product on pets. Prior to reentry, treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets. Repeat as necessary to bring infestation under control.

Foggers alone will not control flea infestations. To control fleas, treat the pet and its inside and outside living areas at the same time. To effectively control fleas you must treat your pet, home and yard.

Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination. In hospitals, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate area for two hours prior to returning patients.

Storage and Disposal

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, flames and other sources of ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in newspaper and dispose in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
