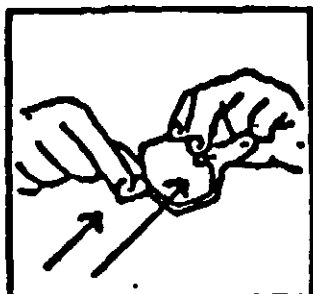

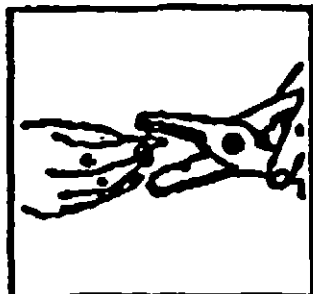
### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

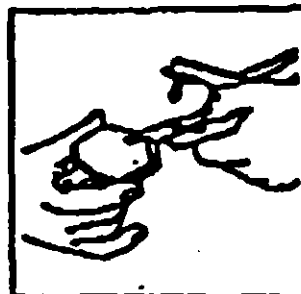
## MORGAN CHARGER EAR TAG AND COLLAR



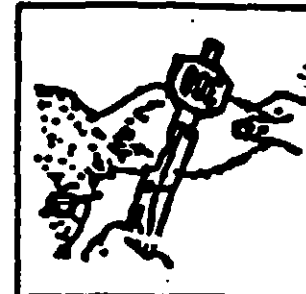
**Figure 1**  
To activate the tag, pull off the tabs for insecticide release and air vent.



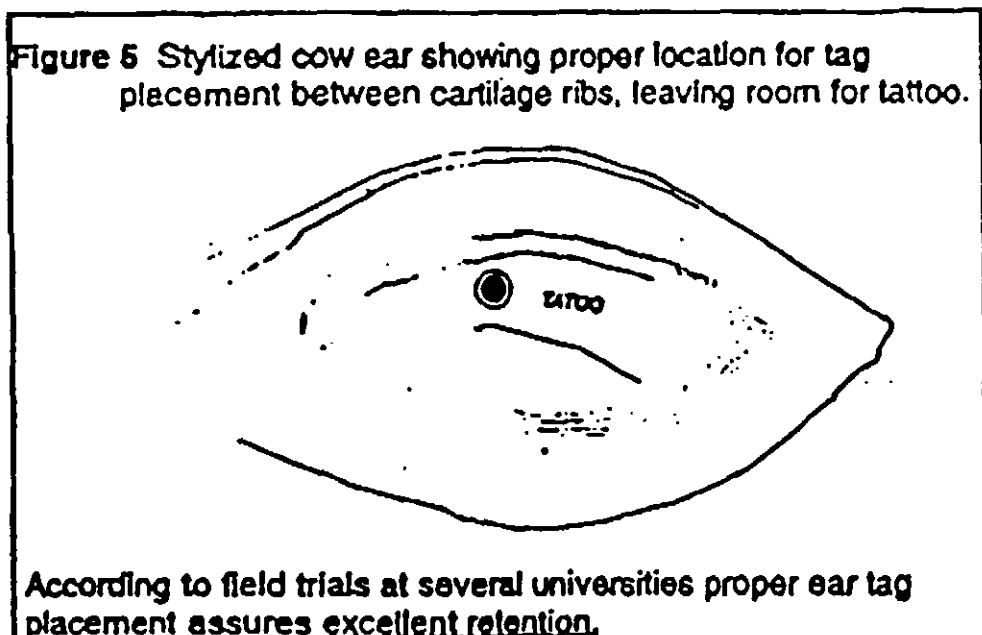
**Figure 2**  
Place the male stud onto applicator pin until it is well seated. Stud is coated with anti-bacterial formulation.



**Figure 3**  
Place female tag under the clip by depressing lever with collar pointing down.



**Figure 4**  
Apply in center of ear halfway between ear tip and head. Do not pierce any cartilage ribs or blood vessels.



For adequate control of horn flies, attach one tag (collar) per animal. For optimum control apply two **Morgan Charger Ear Tags** per head (one in each ear) to provide season long control of horn flies and as an aid in control of Gulf Coast ticks, Spinose ear ticks, lice, face flies, stable flies, and house flies. Apply when flies first appear in the Spring. Tag or collar remains effective up to 6 months. Calves less than 6 months of age should not be tagged as ear damage may result. Apply with the Fearing Du Flex Applicator.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Storage:** Store in a cool place away from direct sunlight. **Pesticide Disposal:** Remove tags and/or collar before slaughter. Wastes (spent tags) resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Container Disposal:** Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
