This product is <u>NOT</u> to be used as a terminal sterilant / high-level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high-level disinfection.

USE: Disinfects and sanitizes clean rooms and controlled areas such as those used in healthcare institutions, biopharmaceutical, pharmaceutical, medical device and diagnostic manufacturing facilities. This product may be used to disinfect non-food contact, non-porous, inanimate, hard surfaces in areas such as: aseptic filling and gowning rooms, general manufacturing areas and laboratories. SANIHOL® ST is an effective sanitizer on inanimate, non-food contact surfaces against Staphylococcus aureus (ATCC#6538) and Enterobacter aerogenes (ATCC#13048) in the presence of 5% fetal bovine serum organic load in 5 minutes.

Storage and Disposal
