The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- Correct label text and format

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the first page of the label by deleting the organisms: *Streptococcus pyogenes* and *Escherichia coli*. Claims for these organisms have not been accepted in the past for this product. If you desire to add either or both to the label of this product, submit an amendment with supporting efficacy data or citations for such data. Such an amendment must be accompanied by product specific as well as generic data matrixes (Agency and Public File copies) as well as Certification with Respect to Citation of Data Forms.

2. Revise the third page as follows:

A. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" statements by changing the subheading "Storage" to read "Pesticide Storage."

B. Delete the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement as it appears in the Precautionary Statements section of the label. This statement is only required on the front panel of the label.

3. Revise the following statement in the "Environmental Hazards" section on page 4: "Do not use on boats or other structures that come into direct contact with aquatic environments, such as concrete pilings." to state: "Do not use on boats or other structures that come into direct contact with aquatic environments." as this statement will now be in agreement with the sites listed on page three.

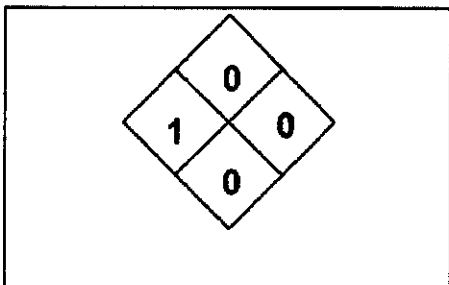

EFFICACY STATEMENT

USES STATEMENT

Simple Green d can be used on washable, non-porous surfaces: floors, walls, counters, bathroom fixtures, rehabilitation, exercise and playground equipment, vehicle interiors and exteriors, linoleum, stainless steel, chrome, glazed tile and porcelain, fiberglass, aluminum, glass, rubber, plastic and concrete in hospitals, clinics, convalescent facilities, locker rooms, athletic centers, hotels, motels, schools, garages, offices, homes, cafeterias and kitchens when food is not present.
