
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

For general cleaning: 1. Wet surface if using full strength or dilute to customize for specific cleaning jobs (see dilution guide). 2. Apply Simple Green d Antibacterial (full strength or diluted) with sponge, mop, or coarse spray. 3. Rinse or wipe off.

Cleaning glass surfaces: Mix 150:1 solution. Apply. Rinse. Wipe dry.
