
Subject: Revised Labeling in Response to PR Notice 91-7
Cajun Roach Spray, EPA Reg. No. 56887-1
Submission dated April 30, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

In accordance with the Sumithrin Registration Standard, modify the label declaration for sumithrin to read: "3-phenoxybenzyl-(1RS, 3RS; 1RS, 3SR)-2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylprop-1-enyl)cyclopropanecarboxylate".

Delete the term "other isomers" from the label ingredients declaration. Unless otherwise substantiated, these isomers should be considered inert. If the "other isomers" are determined to be active, they should be incorporated in the declaration for the active ingredient and not distinguished as "related compounds" or "other isomers".

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS. DO NOT use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

For Household Use and Use in Non Food Areas of Industrial Buildings, Schools, Warehouses, Office Buildings, Theatres, Garages, Hotels, Motels and Kennels:

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE: To Kill: Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas and Carpet Beetles. Attach extens on tube to spray actuator. Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Also spray between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to vents and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and base.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT: To Kill: Cockroaches, Spiders, Silverfish, Ants, and Crickets. Attach extens on tube to spray actuator. Control spray amount as possible with the spray nozzle. Thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Examine and treat decal around window frames, in the yard and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill: Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks. Remove and dispose of bedding. Spray bedding, mattress, floor around base of sofa, bed, chair, and other furniture, cracks and crevices. If you suspect your pet has fleas, DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Bedding should be removed and treated with water. Treat bedding after treatment. Also treat pet and all other animals. Flea and tick collars should be used on pets. Wash throughly after treating area.

FOR SPACE SPRAY: To Kill: Mosquitoes, Stomach-Flying Moths, Gnats, and Wasp. Close doors and windows and shut the spray down at the entrance of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 30 seconds for average room. Empty room and leave for 15 minutes after spraying. Use label on the spray before emptying and before spraying. Before spraying, remove exposed food and dishes. Avoid contact with children and pets. Avoid spraying on electrical equipment, electrical wiring, and other sensitive surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container away from heat, sparks, flame.
Dispose of contents and container as directed.
