2. Add to the phrase "EPA Registration No. 56832-2" to your label before you release the product for shipment.

3. Submit a 1-year storage stability study for the product. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and for 1 year of storage. The data must be submitted in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity with the product stored in containers similar to those that will be used in marketing the product. These data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this registration notice.
Note: You must analyze for both active ingredients in your formulation.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the 2-79 enclosure for a full description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Outdoor and Indoor Use. Read entire label. Use strictly in accordance with label directions.

Most bees and wasps are beneficial, however, when their nests are built too close to windows, doorways, or children's play areas they may be dangerous and should be killed.

User should always use this product with the wind at the user's back. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothing, do not stand directly under nest.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, BEES and YELLOW JACKETS. Point valve away from face and press button. Hold can at least 3 feet away from surfaces to be sprayed. Remove protective cap. Hold container in upright position to spray. Aim valve opening at nest, hold at arms length and depress button, soaking the entire nest with spray. Spray jet will reach nests up to 20 feet above ground. Repeat as necessary. Do not use as a space spray.

Wait 30 seconds, then remove nest using a stick or broom handle. Crush insects and nest and place in trash collection.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
