DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

FOR SPACE SPRAY:

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward in center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 - 10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Attach extension tube to spray actuator. Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Silverfish, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. **Do not spray animals.** Replace old bedding with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Before allowing pets to enter treated area, treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of

delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame or sunlight.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces. Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if warranted.

If On Skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to reuse.

If In Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
