

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Space Spray: To kill house flies, mosquitoes, and gnats. Close room or area to be treated. Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undiluted spray directly from equipment or with electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid spraying face. Direct the fine spray mist toward the upper corners of the room. Full coverage requires 1/2 oz. per 5,000 cu. ft. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate thoroughly.

CONTACT SPRAY: To kill cockroaches, fleas, ants, crickets, silverfish, earwigs, centipedes. Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray on floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets, and other hiding places. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Bedbugs and Lice: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices, walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only on tufts, folds and seams. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestations, etc.

To Kill Fleas: Hold spray nozzle about 18 inches from areas to be treated. Direct spray on areas. Apply spray until areas moist. Treat pet bedding the same way. Also spray as necessary.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jacks: Application should be made in late evening. Hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ants: Spray doors, around window frames, ant trails and hills.

To Kill Grain Insects: Adults of confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetle, cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and livestock feed. Directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects hide.

To control nuisance pests around buildings, patios and paved areas: Apply as a spraying turf or plants.

Earwigs, Sowbugs, Spiders, Centipedes and Millipedes: Apply as a contact spray.
