The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared:

1. Delete the first sentence under ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS, " . . . In case of contact . . . ." This is not an environmental hazard statement and you adequately cover the point under PRACTICAL TREATMENT.
2. Delete the reference to " . . . electrical and other powered applicators . . ." under directions, since you have added a precaution not to use in or on electrical equipment.

The formula dated March 13, 1991 is not correct. If you use 6.3 lb of a 40% a.i. resmethrin source and 993.7 lb of petroleum distillate, that would support the label declaration. Alternatively, if you repack a 0.25% resmethrin in oil, that would support the label declaration.

ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undiluted as a very fine mist space spray through manually operated equipment or with electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least 5 ft. from objects. Direct the fine mist spray mist toward the upper corners of the room. Fill the room with a fine mist spray at the rate of 5 ft. cub. per 5,000 cu. ft. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy insects.

**INSECT SPRAY:** To kill cockroaches, fleas, ants, crickets, silverfish, earwigs, spiders, grain mites, sawbugs, centipedes and beetles: adjust spray to produce large wetting type particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets, and other harborage. Spray these infested areas well thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Bedbugs and Lice:** Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices, around baseboards, floorboards, bedboards and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only the areas that may harbor pests, concentrating on folds and seams. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestations, consult professional applicators.

**To Kill Fleas:** Hold spray nozzles about 18 inches away from areas to be treated. Direct spray on resting areas and floor around these areas. Apply spray until area is moist. Treat pet bedding the same way. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets: Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places contacting as many as possible. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Arts:** Spray doors, around window frames, art trails and hills.

To Kill Grain Insects: Adults of cornmeal flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles: Remove infested grain, cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the area by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed steaks and into cracks and crevices where insects may be hiding.

To control nuisance pests around buildings, patios and paved areas: Apply as a contact spray. Spray directly on insects. Avoid spraying on turf or plants.

**Earwigs, Sowbugs, Spiders, Centipedes and Millipedes:** Apply as a contact spray for indoor use.
