DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

AQUA-GUARD N12 per 1000 gallons of water in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 5 AQUA-GUARD N12 per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 AQUA-GUARD N12 per 1000 gallons every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Store in original container. Do not store more than five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Damaged drums should be placed in overpacks. Do not be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a container closed when not in use.
